

DEEP RIVER ANCIENT MUSTER

Always the third weekend of July

Monday - DRJA practice (place TBD) 6:30pm

Thursday - extra DRJA practice and field set-up needed. Arrive at Devitt's Field at 6:30pm. Parents help set up tents and trailer, etc. Corp will run performance practice on the field.

Friday - Tattoo

Arrive at 6:00, Devitt's Field, full uniform. Usually try to take a DRJA group photo at 6:30pm.

Tattoo performances start promptly at 7:00pm. DRJA performs at 7:00pm!

After all performances, DRJA starts "friendship circle" to begin jamming for the evening (kids can wear DRJA red-tee for friendship circle)

Saturday - Parade

Arrive at 10:30am at the line-up. Corner of Kirtland and Main Street (next to Ivory Restaurant/ Subway). Parade steps-off at 11:00 a.m. Full Uniform

At the end of the parade, the on-stand performances begin. DRJA must be ready to go on-stand soon after the parade ends (after 'F troop'). DRJA goes on-stand 2nd (after the DRDC)

FYI, after marching in the parade with DRJA, the kids can also march in "Vic's Kids" or the "F Troop" on the parade route (with a parent's permission), BUT, they MUST be ready to go on-stand immediately after the parade ends (Full uniform on-stand).

Note:

Vic's Kids is a group that consists of current and former members of the Deep River Junior Ancients. DRJA was formed by Vic Malcarne (Terry Malcarne's father).

F-Troop is anyone who wants to play and march in the parade again, they can 😊 It's a big group.

And loud 😊

On-going throughout the weekend:

DRJA Parking during Tattoo - fundraiser. Parking cars at Stone House. Parents sign-up for time-slot.

DRJA Soda Booth - fundraiser. Friday evening and Saturday all day. Kids are welcome and encouraged to help at the soda booth, but ask at least 2 adults per shift. Parents sign-up for time-slot.

Breakdown of the tents and items generally occurs Saturday evening. Trailer is moved off the field Sunday morning.
